

I have had a blast this summer working on the new colored pencil technique from Meg Hawkey of Crabapple Hill Designs. It takes me back to my high school days, thinking "I'll be an artist when I grow up. Our new Block of the Month, "Summer Kitchen" features the coloring technique, hand embroidery and piecing; it starts September 15, runs for 10 months and is \$22.95 per month.

We had so much fun this summer learning to make our own personal umbrellas! Thank you once again to Judy Gauthier from Bungalow Quilting in Ripon, Wisconsin for showing us how to make them. And if you want one for yourself, check out the class schedule because I'll be teaching it this fall.



We have 2 more new Block of the Month programs starting up.

- A 6-month Christmas BOM, "Sew Merry" from The Quilt Company, starts on November 15 and features fusible appliqué, some simple pieced blocks and printed embellishments. The cost is \$27.95 per month.
- 2. "Where We Love is Home", a very scrappy design from Hatched and Patched, has hand or fusible appliqué, hand embroidery and machine piecing. It starts January 15, runs for 12 months and is \$19.95 per month.







The new session of Hidden Quilt Society starts in October with a quilt from Terry Atkinson's Follow Your Heart. The book has great directions and several projects in addition to the main sampler quilt. We'll be picking colorways in September so be sure to check the Facebook page for the announcement.

Be sure to stop in as we've enlarged the classroom area to hold 12 students and I'm opening up the classroom for "Open Sewing" any day of the week for \$5 for the day. Just call in and check our schedule for availability.

Several people have asked me when the next Beginning Quilting class is. You tell me! This summer I ended up with 5 different classes because I let the students tell me what days and times they wanted. I have no problem with one-on-one classes; just let me know what works for you.
