Our new project for this season is called "Empire Place" by Sassafras Lane Designs. This is a modern geometric paper- pieced quilt by the same designers who did Arcadia Avenue. Sue will host a sew-along that will run 9 months from February to October on the 4th Tuesday of each month. Cost of the sew-along is \$45, provided you purchase the pattern booklet, foundation papers and background from us. Then pull from your stash for the wide variety of colors for the blocks and unique spiked border.

Once again let's "Celebrate the Heart of Quilting" with A Quilters' Road Trip February 1 to 28, 2016. We are one of 14 shops that have joined together to showcase red & white quilt projects, patterns and amazing prizes. You have the entire month of February, more than enough time to visit all or most of the shops to get your creative juices flowing. Each shop will have a pattern and fabric kit available for an 8" sampler block for \$6.00. Final setting directions for the sampler quilt will be available free on the Celebrate the Heart of Quilting web site from March 1st to April 30th. This annual event also includes a silent auction for red and white items to raise money for the American Heart Association. As we all should know by now, heart disease is the number one killer of women. Last year we raised over \$5000; this year we are aiming for \$7500. Each shop will have extra activities for the month also; we will have a nurse here at least one Saturday in February to do free blood pressure readings. Be sure to visit us in February as Lynn from Patches and Petals and myself hold this project very dear to our own heart surgery experiences.

Everyone loves a mystery and Karen will help you solve one starting in February. This is a 2-Color mystery in 6 parts. Every 2 weeks you'll get a new section to do; you'll get instructions and have time to cut and start sewing the blocks in class.

Sat. Feb. 4 is the National Quilts of Valor Sew Along. Come in and strip (!) with Karen and our QOV sew group. Or sew for QOV at home that day – more info at QOVF.org.

Come in from Tues. Jan 31 thru Sat. Feb. 4 to have us pre-cut your fabric choices for the Super "Boll" Sale on Sun. Feb. 5. 25% off storewide (excluding clearance area). Remember you have to come in on Sunday to get the discount.

HIDDEN QUILT SOCIETY

- Meetings held 5 different times monthly with Carol, Sue & Teresa
- Club starts new each October
- One year Hidden Quilts picks the book or pattern we will use for the project and the group picks the color way we will use, the next year we do the opposite
- You pay \$5.00 for the first month's block, you buy your own book or pattern, background and finishing fabrics
- We are offering 2 color ways this season, if you want both the additional kit is an extra \$3.00 per month
- This year you will be bringing back one large block each month in order to keep getting your next kit free; otherwise you must pay \$5.00 to start over
- This will be a demo of different techniques, very informal
- Please bring your show and tell to share with the group
- · Hidden Quilts will have its own show and tell of what's new since last meeting

UNFINSHED OBJECTS

- UFO meets once monthly, afternoon or evening with Sue
- Club starts new each October, running for a year
- Club fee is \$5 to join
- Your projects must be at least 6 months old to qualify as a UFO
- Each month you are required to write down what you would like to accomplish before the next meeting. You must state exactly what you intend to accomplish (for example, make 16 blocks, quilt 2 rows, make binding, etc.) Every item you write down must be brought back the next meeting completed or the fine is \$5 into the kitty for each unfinished item.
- For each completed item on your list, your name is entered into the year-end drawing for Hidden Quilts Gift Certificates.

CLASS POLICIES:

- Pre-registration is a must. We will not hold your spot for class or give out supply list without class registration paid in full at time of registration
- All supplies need to be purchased prior to first class, which will be 20% off anything needed plus book or pattern for class at Hidden Quilts
- We ask no children please, they distract everyone
- Always be at least 15 minutes early for your class, this gives you time to set up & purchase any last minute items
- . Know your sewing machine & make sure it's in good working order before class time
- Bring your Basic Sewing Supplies for each class
- Class time will usually yield the quilt top only
- If you need help beyond class time to finish, feel free to just ask
- All day classes-bring sack lunch, order out or go out, we have refrigerator available

CLASS CANCELLATION:

- We reserve the right to cancel a class if less than 3 students are signed up
- If we need to cancel a class for any reason, refund or store credit will be given
- If you cancel 7 days prior to class, store credit will be issued, if less then 7 days no refund unless a replacement is found for your spot
- If you can't make a class, check with us to see if we can't get you into another time spot if the class is being repeated

First Semester Beginning Quilting

We will be using Eleanor Burn's book <u>It's Elementary</u>" which has wonderful easy directions with lots of pictures to follow. Students will need to make an appointment with me ahead of class time so I can help them to pick out fabric for the class project. If you have fabric you want to use in the project, please bring it along so I can check it out; in the past I have allowed students to use whatever fabric they have but this has just caused too many problems, causing a delay in the class time for everyone. You will find out how important it is to be consistent and accurate at all times. How a few threads off here and there can change the whole outcome of your project. I'll teach you how to cut and press the fabric correctly. You will practice your scant 1/4" seam allowance before moving on to constructing 3 of the (five) 12 ½" blocks from the book into a table runner. This class you will be learn to piece the top of the runner only. Must take Second Semester Beginning Quilting to learn how to finish your runner.
